Using what you know about rhetorical devices and rhetorical fallacies, reread Cassius's speeches from Act I, Scene 2 as he tries to convince Brutus to join the conspiracy. Locate two examples of legitimate uses of rhetorical strategies. Also, locate two examples of attempts to manipulate or mislead by rhetorical fallacy.

- Cite a specific CD of each technique.
- Write CM for each CD explaining how the CD meets the definition of the technique in question.

So, you will have four examples total: two for rhetorical devices and two for fallacies.
